Boating Restrictions have been
lifted effective today!!**

**In order to keep boating open you MUST follow the
Maryland and Bay Boat Works, Inc. regulations below
and in the attached documents:**

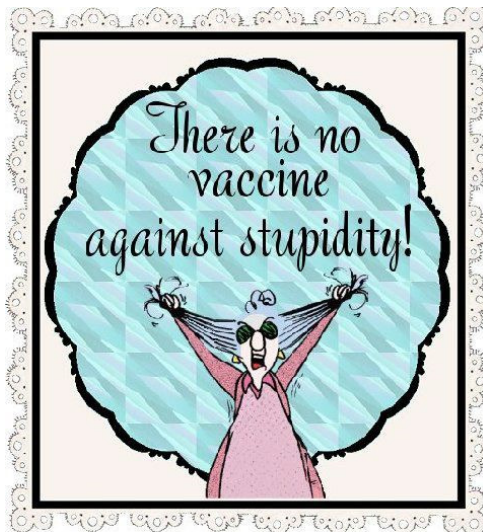
**(NO EXCEPTIONS) – we reserve the right to ask you to leave the
boat yard and you will lose your summer storage)**

- **NO** parties, social groups, gatherings allowed in the boat yard, especially on docks, parking lots, picnic areas. You **MUST** maintain 6 feet distance from everyone (with the exception of immediate family members or others who live with you on land – no more than 10 people).
- **NO** chairs, umbrellas, kayaks, inflatables, or other personal items on the dock – please keep them on your boat or with your vehicle.
- Masks **MUST** be worn when not on your boat and when using the bath house (except showering).
- Please maintain **6 (SIX) FEET DISTANCE** from Bay Boat Works employees and other customers in all areas of the boat yard.
- The fuel dock house has a 6 foot painted blue line with footprints – please **STAY OUT** of this area at **ALL** times.
- Use phone or email to communicate with Bay Boat Works staff, please do not ask them to come out of buildings to talk to you.
- We offer curbside pick-up for marina store items including snacks, ice and drinks – please call to place an order.
- **NO** rafting up – no more than 10 people on your boat at a time. Keep your distance on the water – at least 10 feet away from other boats.
- **STAY AT HOME** when you feel sick or have symptoms.
- **WASH** your hands regularly and use hand sanitizer.
